

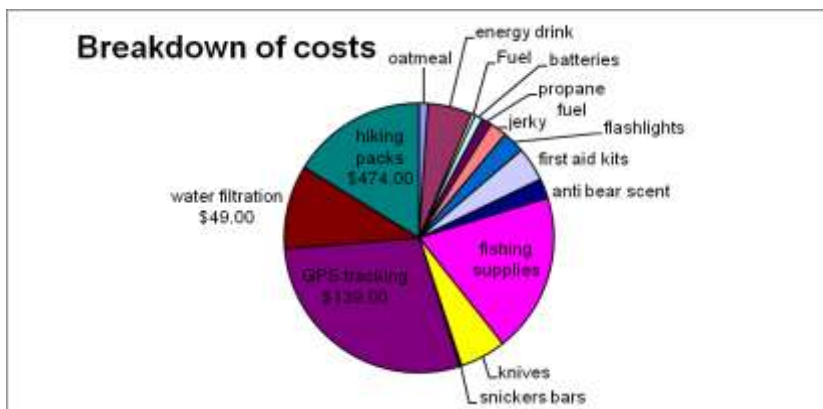
You and 6 of your friends are taking a 2 week hiking trip in Canada this summer. You are the one in charge, so you are going to be the one purchasing all the supplies and gear for the trip.

Your team will consist of YOU and your friends Steve, Brett, Victoria, Nathan, Byron, and Alison. Two of these friends did not graduate from high school and have minimum wage jobs working with the circus. They are worried about being able to afford the trip so you need to put together a spread sheet that includes all expenses. Victoria has a mini van so you will be taking her vehicle. The van gets an average of 28 MPG. The total mileage for the trip will be 2520.

Create a spread sheet for the trip that easily shows the entire cost of the trip by item.

The supplies include:

1. 10 boxes of instant oatmeal @ \$5.13 per box
2. 2 containers of energy drink powder @ \$25.99 per container
3. The cost of fuel @ an average of \$2.20 per gallon
4. 6 packs of AA batteries @ \$4.50 per pack
5. 10 bottles of propane fuel for cooking @ \$6.00 per bottle
6. 15 packages of dried meat and jerky @ \$9.99 per package
7. 4 flashlights @ \$12.99 per flashlight
8. 2 first aid kits @ \$20.00 a piece
9. 1 container of anti bear scent @ \$11.49
10. 1 Supplies for fishing, total cost \$93.00
11. 4 survival knives @ \$27.00 a piece
12. 30 king size snickers bars @ .99 a piece
13. 1 GPS tracking system @ \$139.00
14. 1 water filtration system @ \$49.00
15. 7 hiking packs @ \$79.00 per bag

All items will have a 8 % sales tax applied to their price. Everything that is a dollar amount must be formatted to currency with 2 decimal places and using a dollar symbol. Label each piece of the pie with the same name you used in "item description" and include the total price for that item. Format your cells so that it shows the grid marks.
