Lists are actually pretty simple. To start a list, put either an `` or `` inside the body where you want a list to start. The `` stands for ordered list, and will make your list a numbered list starting with 1. 2. 3. etc... The `` stands for unordered list and will just make bullets like this • Every time you want a new number or bullet just insert the tag `` For example this will create a numbered list for the days of the week. ` Monday Tuesday Wednesday `
